The village lay at the foot of a long, jagged mountain that rose like a threat behind the town. Its sheer face was covered with hard, dark clay and in places rugged with boulders. For miles around the slopes of this mountain, spurs of rock ran down to villages and shebeens and platteland. On the slopes were the rounded masses of stone, like the graves of giants. He had been born there in 1831 and had grown up as a true Bechuana, tanned like a lion and tough as leather. His life had been spent in hunting, war, and raids in the high grasslands that lay between the towns.
